



Post-Operation Instructions for Breast Implant Removal Procedures

Sutures

The incision is closed with a dissolvable suture that runs under the skin and does not require removal.

Dressings

I use a glue dressing. This is waterproof, and you can wash as if it was not there. The glue will dissolve after 3 weeks to leave a healed wound.

Medication

The hospital will discharge you with analgesia as required.

Follow up

Before you are discharged from hospital you should be given a follow up appointment with the nurse after your first week. I normally see you in clinic between 4 and 6 weeks, although I will see you sooner if you have any problems. You should also be given some contact numbers in the event of any problem. If you have any questions or concerns about your recovery, please do not hesitate to email me (anne@annedancey.co.uk) and I will endeavour to get an answer to you the same day. Obviously, if it is more urgent then please contact the ward or clinic on the hospital numbers you will be provided with. In the unlikely event of an emergency, you must phone the hospital or visit your closest NHS Accident and Emergency (A&E) Department.
